Payment of Fees

Pending agreement from the Director of Finances, either one third of the fees can be paid on the first day of each term, or one tenth from September to June.

Fees must be paid by bank transfer, direct debit, or by cheque **by the first day of the first term** to 'The British School of Paris' and sent to the Administrative Office located on the Senior School campus. Any bank charges must be borne by the payer (bank references are shown on the next page). If fees are not paid by the required date, the School reserves the right to charge interest or to request the withdrawal of a student.

Departure

One half term's notice in writing, addressed to the Registrar, is required when withdrawing pupils to avoid one term's fees in lieu. For parents leaving during the course of the year, reimbursement of school fees is carried out as follows:

- Until Christmas: one term invoiced
- Until Spring break: two terms invoiced
- After this: no repayment

Registration Fee

A one-off non refundable payment.

Development Fund

A development fund contribution of € 5.000 is a one-off payment required for all pupils from Reception and is non refundable. This payment is not required at Nursery level.

Tuition Fees

Fees are invoiced annually. For those students joining us during the course of the academic year, fees are calculated in half term units.

Bus Service

Parents who decide to use the bus service are committed financially for the whole of the first term. After Christmas no refund will be made in the event of cancellation of the bus service.

Compulsory School Trips

Compulsory trips are invoiced with the annual school fees; other trips will be invoiced when details are confirmed. Essential curriculum trips are offered at approximately €1.000 each for:

- Years 10 and 12 Geography
- Year 11 History
- Year 12 Business Studies and Design and Technology
- Years 12 and 13 History of Art
- Year 13 Biology

Other Trips

A separate invoice will be issued for other school trips.

Extras

These include uniform, PE clothing, compulsory school trips and private music tuition.

Educational Support Fee Structure 2010/2011

Additional Provision with Supplementary Charge

Support for:

- specific learning difficulties e.g. dyslexia, dyscalculia, ASD, ADHD
- EAL (English as an Additional Language)
- mainstream teaching of curriculum / non-curriculum subjects
- accelerated teaching of a mainstream subject

These services incur an additional termly charge of:

- €800 per term – on the basis of 1 hour per week of 1:1 teaching
- €400 per term – on the basis of 1 hour per week of small group teaching
- €400 per term – on the basis of 1 hour per week of in-class support from a teaching assistant

Exam Access Arrangements

A charge will be applied to arrange access to Examinations/Tests for Educational Support Students, as follows:

- €400 – per child, per report for a professional, Educational Psychologist assessment and report
- €50 – per child, per application to exam boards for access arrangements
- Access arrangements throughout the year (per child €250 in KS2; €500 in KS3, 4 and 5) for:
 - Routine tests
 - Internal exams
 - External exams
- €48 per hour - additional personnel e.g. scribe, prompt, reader

Intensive English (Senior School)

For children enrolled in the Intensive English programme also receiving regular tuition, an all-inclusive fee of €13.300 per term will be charged.

Learning Support (up to KS4 only)

For children requiring continuous 1:1 attention, an all-inclusive fee of €48.000 per annum will be charged.
