



Our New Junior School – Schedule of Construction Newsletter – Edition: 3

We are pleased to report that during the summer months progress on the school continued at a fast rate, well on target for our September 2010 opening. Admissions enquiries are increasing and we are happy to receive your calls regarding places for the September 2010 intake.

During July and August the classroom and office partitioning in the east wing started and the window installations advanced well. In this wing a test classroom has been installed to trial our choices for the positioning of electric wiring, lighting, heating and IT infrastructure.

Elsewhere on site the roof for the multi-purpose hall is now in place and fully insulated. The stage and lighting are complete and it is now possible to visualise the Headmaster presiding over a morning assembly in this new hall.

The construction of the refectory and the kitchens has been completed, including the addition of an outdoor terrace for summer lunches.

The priority for the coming months is to complete the east wing first and then to finish the fitting-out of the rest of the school.

During September, work will continue on the completion of the internal partitioning and the under-floor heating installation will start. The roof and all the windows are to be completed and the pipework for the kitchens will progress.
