Admissions for the New Junior School

We are delighted with the growing interest in our new Junior School. Throughout November and December we experienced a marked increase in the level of enquiries for admission into both nursery and reception class for September 2010. Main entrance and central atrium

The main entrance to the school now includes the large reception area complete with glass atrium. This provides the ground floor with a flood of natural light to create a welcoming, airy space for both children and guests.



The lift to all floors has been installed in reception offering ease of access for all students, staff and visitors.

Video phone entrance doors plus surveillance cameras placed strategically around the school will provide a high level of security for the children.

Multi-purpose hall

The multi-purpose hall is now being fully sound proofed using a specific type of plaster board with integrated sound insulation. This hall will host a whole range of events for the school as well as the local community, ranging from concerts to basketball matches.



Nursery and reception



The nursery and reception classes on the ground floor are now being fitted-out. Each class will have a designated wet play area with a sink and pvc flooring as well as a carpeted main area for teaching. The separate dining room and preparation kitchen are situated alongside the classrooms to ensure ease of access for our smallest pupils. The tables and chairs are scaled to the appropriate size and all the counters are also at a lower height. These classrooms are further complimented by large open activity areas situated along the corridor between the classrooms to facilitate group activities.

Outside recreation space

Outside the play areas are being cleared in preparation for playing fields and recreation spaces. There is a dedicated, enclosed area especially for our nursery pupils.

We are lucky to benefit from the magnificent views of the Seine.



Brick finishing is now being added to the outside walls and the outside colour scheme has been agreed in preparation for the completion of the whole school in early 2010.
